SUMMARY OF POSITION:

Under the supervision and direction of the assigned WSRM Truck Driver, safely and courteously assist with pick-ups and deliveries between Donors, Thrift Store buyers, and WSRM.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Help the driver in all aspects of the truck pickup and delivery process.
- Receive and follow instructions from the WSRM Truck Driver regarding pick-ups and deliveries.
- Responsible for getting out of the truck upon arrival at each stop and guiding the driver into the parking spot.
- Responsible for placing the wheel chock down before the truck is opened up.
- Responsible for helping the driver secure each load inside the truck before leaving for the next stop.
- Assist in the loading and unloading of the truck.
- Help the driver clean interior and exterior of truck on a weekly basis, or as needed.
- Responsible for providing respectful, courteous service with a “can do” attitude.
- Interact with and respond to donors, customers, WSRM employees and guests in a professional, helpful manner.
- Responsible for being neatly groomed to represent WSRM in a professional manner at all times.
- Additional duties as assigned.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- High school diploma or GED preferred.

- Christian with a ministry mindset, utilizing the skills, training and experience God has provided.
